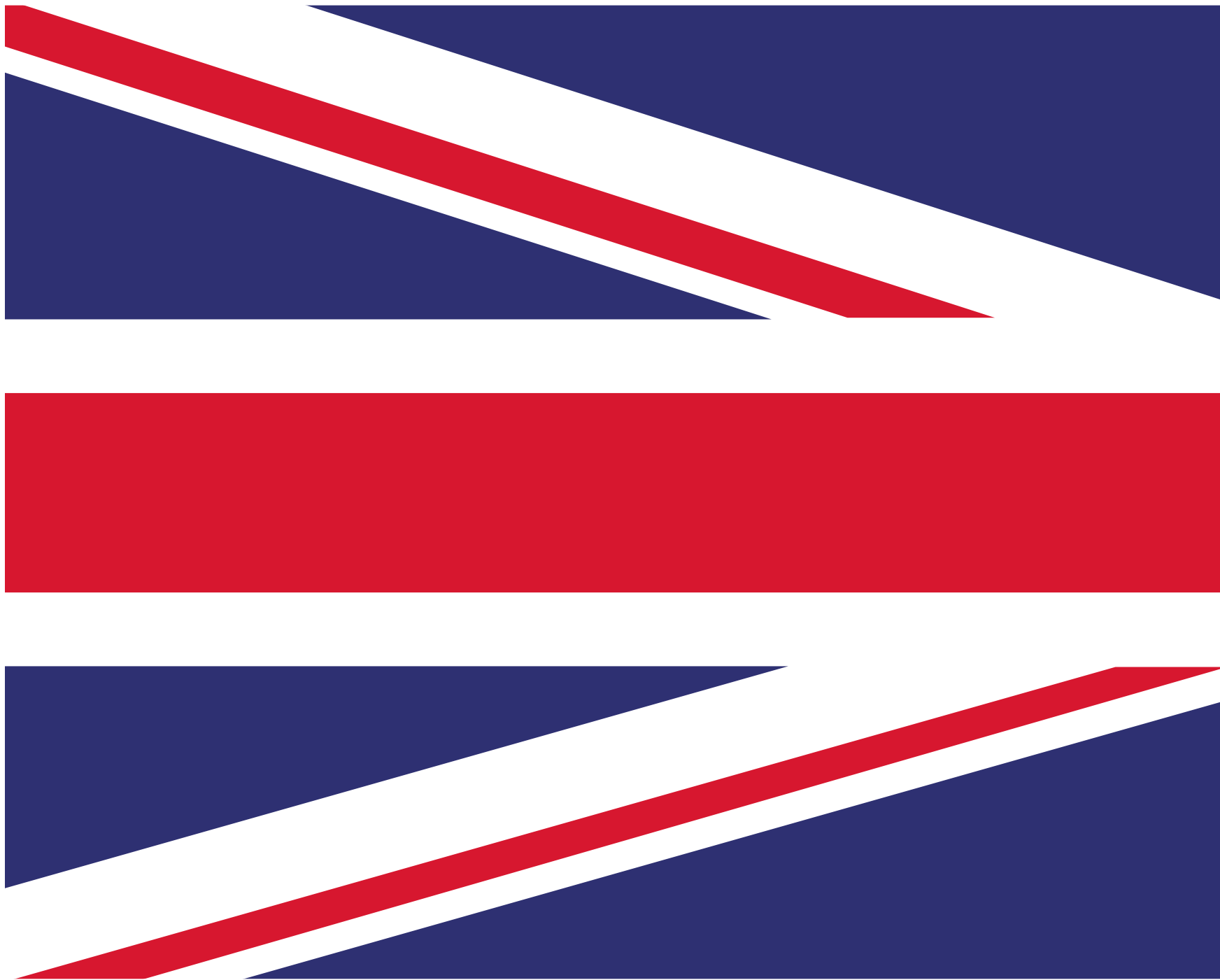

A WORD FROM THE PRESIDENT

It is with great satisfaction that I once again share this summary of the operations undertaken by the Ecopilas Foundation over the course of a further year. In 2013, as we have been doing since we began our efforts in 2008, we addressed the challenge of guaranteeing a better future, based on the principle of a firm commitment of responsibility to our members, the public authorities, citizens and society at large.

This account would not, though, be a realistic one if we were to overlook the macroeconomic situation we are living through, and the consequent decline seen in consumption which has over recent years accompanied our efforts. Despite this economic cycle, the results achieved by Ecopilas in 2013 could not be more positive, strengthening our conviction that the only possible route at the crossroads we face is the path leading to a more sustainable model.

In 2013, then, we easily surpassed our target of collecting 25% of the batteries and accumulators sold, as established by European and Spanish legislation, amassing more than 2,880 tonnes, the equivalent of 35% of the volume placed on the market by manufacturers. I wish in this regard to emphasise furthermore that the industrial channel grew by 42% during the year compared with 2012.

In order to achieve these figures we expanded what is already the most extensive network of recycling collection points in the country, from 25,000 in 2012 to 28,000 in 2013. Ecopilas also increased its number of member companies to a total of 658.

All these figures serve to underscore the leading position enjoyed by Ecopilas in the management of batteries and portable and industrial accumulators in this country, consolidating our position as a European flagship. The account we present would not, though, be complete without mentioning the great leaps forward we achieved in terms of quality in 2013.

We first of all implemented a new waste collection operation for hybrid and electric vehicle batteries. We received in this initiative the support and trust in our management model of the leading manufacturers in the sector. Meanwhile, numerous countries in Latin America reached the conclusion in 2013 that Ecopilas represented the most effective system from the perspective of logistics and the environment for the development of their own sustainable growth policies.

We feel satisfaction at having achieved the goals we set ourselves in 2013. Our task of guaranteeing a better future is nonetheless an ongoing one, and these reports unquestionably give us the optimism and renewed strength which allow us to surpass the milestones and challenges to come.

INTRODUCTION

With a view to 2015, when in accordance with European regulations Spain will be required to recycle 45 per cent of all batteries sold, the Ecopilas Foundation continues to dedicate considerable logistical efforts to enhancing the process involved in the collection, management and treatment of batteries and accumulators.

In parallel, great efforts were made during 2013 in partnership with numerous organisations with a distinctly social and sporting flavour to help raise public awareness across all ages of the importance of taking used batteries and accumulators to the more than 27,000 recycling points set up by Ecopilas at major retail centres and various other establishments throughout the country.

We placed a particular emphasis on children and young people, who have proved themselves to be the leading opinion-formers in families, given their particularly high level of awareness. For their benefit, in partnership with other integrated management systems such as Ambilamp and the Ecosimelec and Tragamovil Foundations, we launched the Recycling School, which spent the academic year touring practically every region of Spain... Together with the Regional Department in Galicia, Sogama and Ecoembes, among others, we took part in the Recycling Caravan and the "Separen..." Campaign, which travelled to more than a hundred towns and villages throughout the region of Galicia, attracting more than 37,000 visitors.

We also supported the staging of sporting events throughout the country, including the Tour of Spain, the Descenso del Sella canoe race, football and rugby, emphasising the links between sport and the environment, by highlighting the values and objectives we share.

Within the current context we remain committed to responsible consumption and the balance which must be struck between economic and environmental needs, with a particular focus on enhancing the efficiency of the treatment and management of waste, along with a whole range of actions intended to make our model the most competitive in the marketplace.

We once again wish to express our thanks first of all for the commitment of our member companies, in terms of all the battery and accumulator producers who have trusted and continue to trust in our selective collection and appropriate waste management model, and also all those consumers who have shown their commitment to environmental sustainability through the recycling and recovery of raw materials.

The ECOPILAS team is made up of professionals with outstanding technical training and professional experience, whose great dedication and vocation in serving members is reflected at every operational division involved in the Foundation's efforts.

- **ECOPILAS** A collective waste management system for batteries and accumulators, set up in the year 2000 by the leading battery and accumulator manufacturers, and is today a leading organisation in Spain and Europe in the management of this type of waste. With more than **658 member companies**, it represents some 60% of the Spanish market.

Its network, with about **27,000 recycling collection points**, has successfully managed more than **12,000 tonnes of used batteries and accumulators** since the entry into force of Royal Decree 106/2008, achieving collection ratios of 35% of all portable batteries placed on the market, well in excess of the legal target of 25%, making it not only the flagship system nationwide, but also one of the most significant in Europe.

- **BOARD OF TRUSTEES** The Board of Trustees of Ecopilas is the Foundation's governing body, and is made up of representatives of battery and accumulator manufacturing companies, manufacturers of electrical and electronic devices fitted with batteries, representatives from the distribution sector and experts in the field of batteries and accumulators.

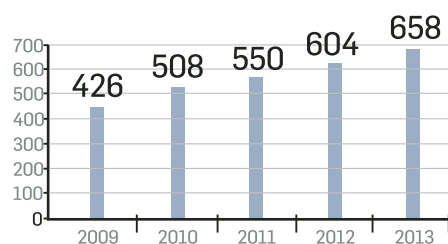

On behalf of its member companies, Ecopilas reports to the National Register of Battery and Accumulator Manufacturers (the REI-RPA) the volumes released onto the Spanish market in accordance with the type and technology of battery and accumulator, in accordance with the obligations derived from Royal Decree 106/2008.

By 2013, **658 companies** had signed up to Ecopilas, which handles the funding of the corresponding responsibility quota with regard to waste collection, according to the representativity data which it provides to the REI-RPA.

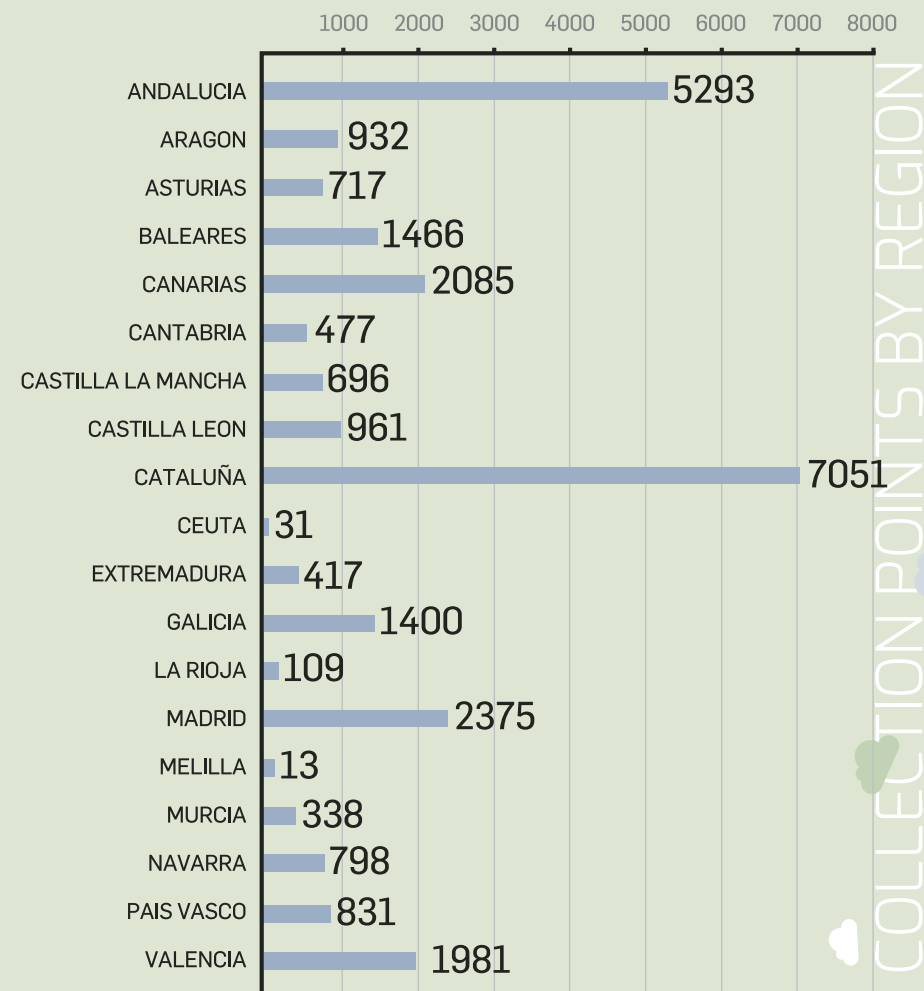
COLLECTION POINTS BY REGION

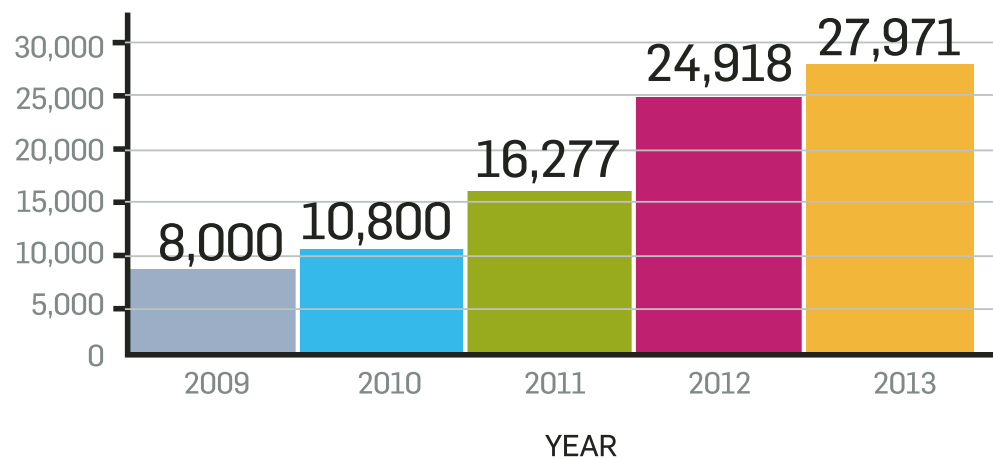

Ecopilas has created the most extensive collection network in the country, with our web management platform providing full traceability of the waste collection, management and treatment process, in turn allowing us to monitor and supervise the deployment of containers at the collection points.

FULFILMENT OF THE PORTABLE BATTERY TARGETS FOR 2013

Through the deployment of Ecopilas containers, the cooperation of collection points and the response of the general public, we achieved a portable battery collection rate of 35%, making this one of the most efficient systems in Europe.

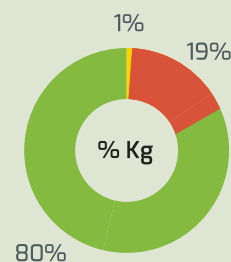
In 2013 a total of 2,884,928 kg of batteries and accumulators was collected, with a notable increase in the collection of industrial batteries, rising from 12.5% in 2012 to a proportion of 19% of the total kilos collected by Ecopilas in 2013.

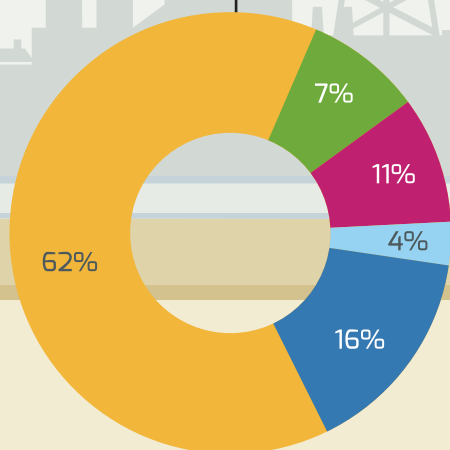

Ecopilas includes 658 manufacturing and import companies in various operational sectors...

Ecopilas represents more than **658 companies** which manufacture, import and market batteries and accumulators in various operational sectors, including above all consumer electronics, telephony and information technology firms producing electrical and electronic apparatus fitted with batteries and accumulators, which account for **32% of the total**, while the battery and accumulator sector represents **14% of member companies**.

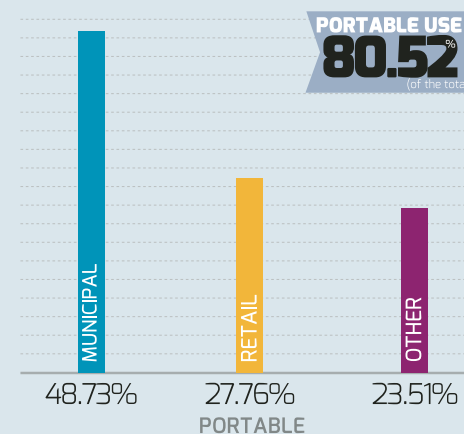

The Ecopilas Foundation has a special container to collect waste button cells. Some 11 kg per container are collected, equivalent to more than 8700 button cells. These containers can be found above all at hearing aid suppliers and other establishments generating button cells.

During 2013 collections from the industrial channel rose considerably, by 42% compared with the previous year. This is thanks to the efforts made by the Foundation in this sector last year and the introduction of two new operations:

INDUSTRIAL Ni-Cd CHANNEL

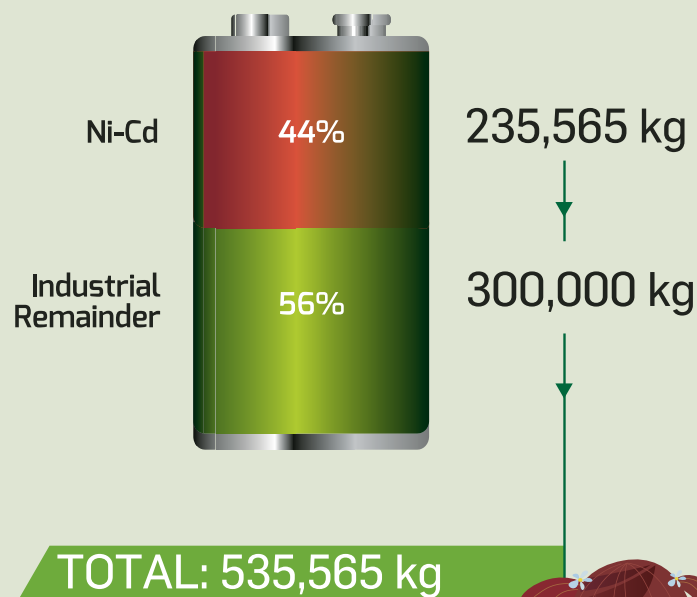
The main operation within this channel is the collection of industrial Ni-Cd batteries. These batteries are collected essentially from companies in the electrical, rail transport and gas and oil sectors.

In order to monitor operations a working group involving the leading companies in the sector was set up in 2010. At its annual meetings it typically reviews the results from the previous year and devises the strategy for the following year.

INDUSTRIAL LEAD CHANNEL

The collection of industrial lead waste batteries has increased substantially thanks to a new operation introduced in partnership with the various lead foundries in Spain. Thanks to this new operation the pricing of collection points has become more competitive in terms of the value of the lead, while Ecopilas helps ensure that the metal is properly recycled.

In 2013, 184,206 kg were collected



HYBRID/ELECTRIC VEHICLE BATTERIES

Meanwhile, a new collection operation has been set up for hybrid or electric vehicle battery waste.

During 2013 partnership agreements were reached with the most significant companies in the automotive sector releasing this type of vehicle onto the market. The collection of such batteries has been developed in partnership with the manufacturers through collaboration with their corporate programmes.

This is perhaps the most novel challenge facing the Ecopilas Foundation in the medium term, given the new technology involved in these batteries (which are essentially based on Ni-Mh and Li-ion), as well as the new channels and collection operations to be deployed, essentially at dealerships and car repair workshops.



DID YOU
KNOW THAT...?

Electric vehicle batteries are classified as industrial USE rather than Automotive, as the Ni-Mh or Li-ion batteries are used for vehicle propulsion. Automotive batteries, according to the definition established in Royal Decree 106/2008, are confined to those used for vehicle starter motors and lights.

ONE YEAR ON SOCIAL NETWORKS

In early 2013 following the launch of its new website, the Ecopilas Foundation created its social profile on the main social networks.



@Ecopilas has been particularly active on Twitter, with more than **1,400 tweets** posted over the period, almost 2 tweets per day, including daily thanks to our new followers, the main activities organised and those in which Ecopilas is involved, retweets of issues of interest and tweets generated in house. We now have close on **a thousand followers**.

The Facebook Fan Page has amassed **340 fans**, and is followed in particular for such sporting activities as the Tour of Spain, rugby competitions, collaboration with the Real Madrid Foundation, consulted by more than 3,000 – 4,000 users, etc.

The Facebook page features most major new items drawn from www.ecopilas.es regarding announcements and events, which are also posted in parallel on the NEWS page www.ecopilas.es/news on the website itself, which is permanently updated and receives more than 6,700 visits. The home page of our website, meanwhile, receives more than **28,000 visits**.

A New York subway train carries 1,200 people. The Ecopilas News section was viewed around 6,700 times in 2013. If it were a New York subway train it would take around 6 trips to transport the number of people who viewed the fifty or so new articles published in the section.

SECOND YEAR OF THE MOBILE RECYCLING SCHOOL



A total of 26,500 students at 224 schools in the Basque Country, Navarre, Madrid, Aragon, La Rioja, Murcia and Valencia visited the Mobile Recycling School during the 2012-2013 academic year.

This environment education initiative promoted by Recyclia focuses on students in Primary years 5 and 6 and Secondary years 1 and 2, and aims to raise the environmental awareness of the school community, providing education about the importance of the selective collection and subsequent recycling of electrical and electronic devices, and used batteries and accumulators.

The Recycling School is an interactive mobile classroom inside which the students are presented with touchscreens, video screenings and an animated 3D film. A series of activities takes students on an interactive tour during which they learn to recycle lightbulbs, batteries, mobile phones, computers, toys and small household appliances, as well as the importance of their contribution to safeguarding the environment.

This educational project has since November 2011 visited schools throughout Spain. By the 2012-2013 academic year more than 48,000 pupils had visited the mobile classroom.

2013 TOUR OF SPAIN

As part of its policy to promote environmental awareness-raising among the public, Ecopilas was for the third year running again involved in the Tour of Spain, as the main sponsor of the points prize in the 2013 race.

The Foundation once again made use of the sporting, social and media impact of the tour to highlight the importance of recycling used batteries by handing out the green jersey during the 10 stages of the race, which ended on 15 September in Madrid. In the Spanish capital Alejandro Valverde received from José Pérez, President of Ecopilas, the jersey acknowledging his status as the points champion of the 68th edition of the Tour of Spain.

As is now traditional, the cyclist claiming the green jersey at the end of each stage placed some used batteries in a container identical to the 28,000 which Ecopilas has distributed all across Spain, thereby helping to publicise the importance of the selective collection of this type of waste.

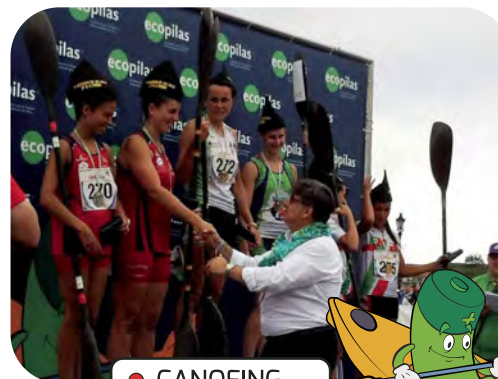

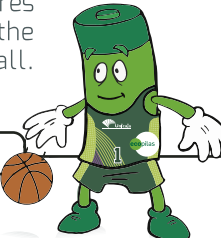

The Ecopilas environmental foundation played a key role in the match between the Unicaja and Barcelona basketball teams, at the launch in Malaga of the "United by Recycling" campaign, with the aim of promoting the selective collection of used batteries and accumulators, and of highlighting the environmental benefits of recycling among the followers of the Malaga-based team.

As a part of the initiative, Ecopilas installed containers allowing fans to get rid of their used batteries at the official stores of the Unicaja team and at the entrance to the Sports Hall.



In all these competitions Ecopilas provided the fans with containers in which they could deposit their used batteries, while also learning in greater detail about the features of the collection and recycling process applied to waste batteries, as well as the environmental benefits.

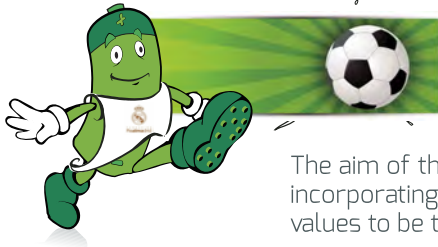

• SEGOVIA FOOTBALL AND ENVIRONMENT SCHOOL

During 2013 Ecopilas renewed its partnership agreement with the Real Madrid Foundation to continue for a further year the Social Football and Environment Sports School in Segovia. Launched two seasons ago, it benefits 80 young people aged between 5 and 17, who train on the 7-a-side Nueva Segovia pictures provided by the Municipal Sports Institute run by the City Council.

The Segovia Football and Environment School sets aside 50% of places for boys and girls belonging to groups at risk of social exclusion, fostering their integration and coexistence within a context based on equality.

The aim of this educational project is to help build closer ties between sport and society, while incorporating environmental awareness and education in tolerance, both of which are essential values to be taught to future generations.



• BOBATH FOUNDATION

Ecopilas has renewed its partnership with the Bobath Foundation to improve the quality of care and education delivered to children with cerebral palsy and brain damage. The environmental foundation will continue to assist in organising extracurricular outings for the 77 pupils studying during the 2013-2014 academic year at the special education institution run by the Bobath Foundation in Madrid.

The purpose of these extracurricular outings is to complement the educational programmes, contributing to the cognitive development of the students, and thereby facilitating their social integration and allowing them to achieve the greatest possible degree of autonomy in their daily life.



MARTÍNEZ RUIZ DE IRÚS FOUNDATION

Ecopilas has contributed to the "Solo queda lo que damos" initiative run by the Martínez Ruiz de Irús Foundation, thanks to which 50 children and youngsters aged between 10 and 18 with a mental disability attended the summer camp staged in July in the town of Calzadilla de Barros in Badajoz.

The environmental foundation was involved in the 3rd Charity Golf Championship, in partnership with the Ángeles Urbanos Foundation and a score of other companies and institutions in order to fund this project, which promotes the social integration of disabled youngsters and the development of their abilities in natural and beneficial settings.

ECOENCUENTRO 2013: "The new regulatory framework for the recycling of WEEE in Spain"

The environmental platform Recyclia focused the third edition of its annual gathering, EcoEncuentro 2013, on the incorporation within Spanish law of the new Directive 2012/19/EU on the recycling of waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE).

The conference, which took place on 26 November in Madrid, brought together representatives from the public authorities and all agents involved in the sector to debate and analyse the main implications and opportunities offered by this new legal framework for the recycling of electronic waste in this country.

All participants at EcoEncuentro 2013 agreed as to the need for the legislation implementing the Directive to focus on the design of a management model for WEEE which will improve and consolidate the current system, with a particular emphasis on increasing collection rates and the job creation capacity of the sector.



"OUR WASTE IS OUR RESPONSIBILITY"

The Ecopilas Foundation launched during 2013 a campaign with the slogan **"Our waste is our responsibility"**, which involved installing a new form of container for waste electronic and electrical equipment at hypermarkets.

The aim of the initiative is to provide an easier and more direct way for consumers to deposit their obsolete electronic equipment, guaranteeing proper environmental treatment and re-use of the usable materials they contain.

To this end Recyclia collaborated in the design of a container with three compartments, each intended for a different type of material: small-size waste electrical and electronic equipment, energy-saving and fluorescent lightbulbs, and portable batteries and accumulators.

During 2013 El Corte Inglés and the Leroy Merlin retail centres in Catalonia joined the **"Our waste is our responsibility"** campaign. In the long term, the aim of Recyclia is to introduce this multiple container nationwide at hypermarkets and retail centres, as well as shops and chains selling DIY materials and household appliances, and in general any locations selling this type of electrical and electronic equipment.



AWARENESS-RAISING CAMPAIGNS

Within the context of its partnership agreements with the regional public authorities, Recyclia launches a range of public environmental awareness-raising campaigns, in cooperation with other Integrated Management Systems (or IMSs).

One of these is the “Reciclem-los” campaign, in cooperation with the Catalan Waste Agency. Its aim is to inform consumers about the network of collection points available across the region, allowing them properly to dispose of their end-of-life electrical equipment.

This goes hand-in-hand with the “Separemos ben, reciclem mellor” initiative promoted by the Department of the Environment of the Autonomous Regional Government of Galicia, with the aim of highlighting the importance of recycling and its environmental benefits, across more than 150 districts in the region. This involves a specially adapted vehicle which has been travelling to the towns around Galicia since the summer of 2013, providing environmental information to the population courtesy of specialist monitors.

Lastly, mention should be made among these campaigns of Recyclia's involvement in the “WEEE Recycling Manual for Teachers”, produced by the Department of the Environment of the Region of Valencia, as part of the Sig-escoles initiative, a recycling education and awareness-raising programme. The manual provides teachers with the resources and knowledge required to convey to their students the environmental benefits of recycling the small-scale electrical appliances they use in their daily life.

EUCOBAT is the organisation grouping together the main Integrated Management Systems recycling batteries and accumulators in the different countries of Europe. Ecopilas has been a member of the executive body since it was founded in 2012.

During 2013 EUCOBAT was heavily involved in conducting a study into Safety during Transportation of lithium battery waste, closely monitoring the updates to the new ADR which came into effect last year in terms of the transportation of waste batteries and/or accumulators, and publishing a number of lobby papers with the aim of explaining the interests of its members in Europe. The strategy for 2014 was lastly

defined, placing the emphasis on the commencement of work to propose improvements to European battery regulations to be incorporated in the future revision of the Directive, which may take place in 2016.

Ecopilas advises the Chilean government on development of its battery and accumulator recycling system

The Ecopilas Foundation has been advising the Chilean government on the development of a management model for the collection and recycling of used batteries and accumulators based on the Spanish system, which is one of the most mature, and with the greatest potential to be exported beyond Europe thanks to its environmental and logistical efficiency. Chile is addressing this project because of the environmental impact derived from the absence of a system which can properly supervise and manage waste amounting to more than 200 million batteries arbitrarily disposed of each year.

The delegation which visited Santiago de Chile held a number of meetings with representatives of the national executive, including the Vice-Minister for the Environment, Ricardo Irarrázabal, and the Latin American Battery Association.

Ecopilas President José Pérez was in turn involved in the "Seminar on Waste Responsibility" hosted by the Chilean capital, attracting the leading representatives of the waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) and used battery and accumulator recycling sector in the country.

Lastly, a delegation from the Chilean Ministry of the Environment, headed by Lorna Püschel, a lawyer at the Legal Division, visited Spain to learn in greater detail about the application of legislation regarding the extended liability of the manufacturer with regard to waste management.
